#### Personal Data Privacy

Notts Save A Life Ltd are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your dealings with us, Terry Draycott is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

#### What personal data we hold on you?

#### How long we hold your personal data

Any paper copies of personal data we hold on you will be securely destroyed after three years, or the expiry of the qualification, whichever is the soonest. Electronic data will be held for 6 years.

#### Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you have the right at any time to:

- Request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data;
- restrict or object to certain kinds of processing, including direct marketing, the portability of your personal data;
- complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority or the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the company. Should you choose not to we may not be able to participate in any of our activities.
